<u>Challenge</u>. Cindy Hutton completed the rules and began to sell kits for the Challenge at the chapter meetings. She has sold 45 kits and there are only 21 left. Challenge entries will be turned in at the July chapter meetings. *The final forms are attached*.



Every Quilt Tells a Story

Our personal stories, as quilters, often center around our homes. The places where we enter the world, grow, love, raise families, cry, mourn and rejoice cannot help but influence our creative life as quilters.

This year's challenge is to illustrate some of that "home life" in a challenge quilt. You may think of your family home, your home of origin, a foster home, a broken home, a home ravaged by natural disaster, a historic home that you love, the home of a friend or beloved pet. Turn that thought into a quilt. You can be quite literal (an applique of the White House in D.C.) or symbolic (a log cabin block in your mother's favorite colors).

Let your heart guide your hands!

2018 TQG CHALLENGE RULES:

- * Start by purchasing a package of the challenge fabrics (four fat eighths) for \$5.00 at any guild meeting. You must use some of each of these fabrics although the amount is left to your vision and imagination; you will supplement the project with fabrics from your stash. All challenge fabrics must be visible from the front of the quilt.
- ❖ Each entry cannot exceed a total perimeter of 80". You must attach a sleeve on the back of the quilt, commensurate with the size of your entry.
- * You may use any technique or combination of techniques to illustrate your story.
- ❖ Each entry must be accompanied by a 3" x 5" index card briefly explaining what personal story is portrayed in your challenge quilt and include only your guild number as identification (i.e. no name or email address).
- ❖ Each entry must have a label sewn to the back of the challenge, including membership number and EITHER telephone number or email address.

- All entries and registration forms must be submitted no later than the July 2018 TQG chapter meetings.
- ❖ Winners will be selected by popular vote of Quilt Show attendees. Any effort to influence the popular vote, overtly or covertly, brought to the attention of the Quilt Show Committee will be cause for immediate disqualification.
- ❖ Challenge Prizes: \$100.00 gift card for First Place; \$75.00 gift card for Second Place; \$50.00 gift card for Third Place.
