The meeting was called to order by Committee Chair Karan Fisher at 6:30 p.m. on February 6, 2018. The Minutes were approved as corrected by motion from Millie Johnson and seconded by Ann Walls.

<u>Vendors</u>. Two more vendors have paid. Heather Hancsak and Sybil Magrill will seek more vendors at the Mid-Atlantic Quilt Show.

<u>Committee Quilt</u>. The committee quilt is complete and was ooo'd and ahhh'd at. Lola has been selling tickets at chapter meetings and at this meeting. The quilting by Christie is wonderful as is the red flange binding by Joan Bryan.

<u>Vouchers</u>. The draft voucher was sent by email to everyone. There was one change. It will be made but the final version will not be sent out so as to prevent any counterfeit vouchers from appearing.

<u>Special Exhibits and Workshops</u>. Steve Albright asked if we would like to use some of his antique quilts to decorate the hall. We will accept his kind offer. Augusta Cole is confirmed for Friday and Sarah Madsen for Saturday. Contracts are being signed. There is to be a special exhibit for 18U Junior Quilters. Also Quilts of Valor and possibly Project Linus will have a special exhibit.

<u>Registration</u>. Gray Castro and Ruth Nixon reported that the final form has been printed and have started to be distributed at meetings. The rules are printed on bright neon paper and the form will be available on the website.

<u>Pins</u>. Millie will order pins at the appropriate time from the same company that we used in 2016.

<u>Publicity</u>. Because of illness Ilona Bruner had to step down from Publicity. Millie Johnson stepped up to do that job as well. It was too late to get an ad into the Mancuso program but 5,000 postcards were ordered and 500 will be available at the Mancuso Mid-Atlantic Quilt Show in February. She gave a supply to Darlene Price to have put on the tables in the convention hall and on the raffle quilt table. Postcards will be mailed to VQC, local guilds, the Museum table at Mancuso, local quilt shops and meetings.

Door Prizes. The list is complete and letters will go out soon.

<u>Special Edition Newsletter</u>. Karan will continue the tradition of having special editions of the Newsletter dedicated to our Quilt Show.

<u>Ribbons</u>. Debbie Williams' Bee has created the design for the Ribbons. They will be in TQG colors with special embroidery for first and second and for each category.

<u>Treasurer</u>. The treasurer's report as of December 28, 2017 was submitted. *A copy is attached*. Two more vendors have paid: Quiltricks and Stone Row Studio. We now have four paid vendors and hope to get fifteen.

Program. Karan asked that each member of the Committee try to get program ads.

Café. Karan mentioned that Angela Cartwright can help with café.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:10 p.m. The next meeting is March 6, 2018 in the Conference Room at 6:30 p.m. at Community United Methodist Church, 1072 Old Kempsville Road, Virginia Beach.
