Strips: Use 100% quilter's cotton fabric. Do not wash, do cut a straight edge. It helps to start by cutting one straight edge, then cut strips from the other end. From one yard, cut fabric 2½" wide from selvage to selvage. You will get 14 strips approx. 45" long. Place strips in plastic bag with your name, TQG #, and phone #. Follow the theme for the month, turn in at each month meeting, and you will receive a variety pack of that theme next month.

Fat Quarters: Use 100% quilter's cotton fabric. 1/2 yard of fabric cut in half perpendicular to the selvage resulting in a piece 18" by half the width of the fabric. At each meeting there is a drawing for fat quarters amongst those who submit them.

6" Squares: Use 100% quilter's cotton fabric. You will need to wash, dry and press ¾ yard of fabric. Straighten edge and remove selvages. Cut 24) 6" squares, place in a bag with your name, phone #, and TQG # on the outside. (Night chapter participants earn participation tickets making you eligible for more prizes.)
