

Cut (2) $-2\frac{1}{2}$ inch white or cream squares.

Cut (4) - 6 inch Asian print squares, either all different or two of one print and two of another print. If you don't have any Asian fabric, you can use floral prints and it will go nicely with the Asian theme.

Snowball two of the 6 inch squares, each with a 2 ½ inch square on one corner only. Cut away outer triangle and iron open. (You will still have a 6 inch square.)

Now make a four patch with the remaining squares. The two snowballed corners should be opposite and diagonal to each other, when sewn together, they make a butterfly in the center.
