# January 2024 BOM: Rope and Anchor

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## Cutting Instructions:



Blue
A (2) $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
B (1) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 18-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip
C (1) $4-{ }^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square

## Brown/Tan

D (2) $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
E (2) $1-{ }^{3} / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 18-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips


NOTE: Read all directions before beginning. You need two fat quarters, one blue and one brown/tan with contrast. Tip: Use your cell phone camera to take a photo of your fabric selection and then use a filter to see the tone in black and white to determine if you have enough contrast. Sew all seams using a scant ${ }^{1} / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam unless instructed to sew on the line.

1. To make the hour glass blocks, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the two blue A $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
2. Pair one blue A 5-1/2" square and one brown D 5-1/2" square, right sides together. Sew $1 / 4$ " on both sides of the drawn line (figure 1).
3. Cut each square on the drawn line (figure 2). Open and press to the dark side.
4. You will have 4 half square triangles. Pair them up right sides together so that the blue touches the brown and nest the seams. Draw a diagonal line perpendicular to the seam and sew $1 / 4$ " on both sides of the drawn line (figure 3). Tip: if you peel back the top layer it should resemble the color layout in figure 4.

5. Cut on the drawn line (figure 3). Press open. Square each hour glass block to 4-1/2" $\times 4$ $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Make sure to have the diagonal lines centered on ruler going both ways when squaring this block.
6. Repeat steps 1-5 for the second set of blue and brown A \& D 5-1/2" squares. You will have four finished hour glass blocks each measuring $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (figure 4).

7. To make the strip sets, sew strip B to strip E. Press to the dark side. Add another $\mathbf{E}$ to the opposite side to make a strip set of $\mathbf{E} / \mathbf{B} / \mathbf{E}$ (figure 5). Press to the dark side.
8. Sub cut strip set $\mathbf{E} / \mathbf{B} / \mathbf{E}$. into four $4-1 / 2^{1}$ squares (figure 5). There is a small amount of waste to allow for squaring your strip set.
9. All blocks are now $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Arrange blocks per the diagram including center blue square $\mathbf{C}$.

10. Sew the blocks together in rows and then sew the rows together (figure 6). Press.
11. Unfinished Rope and Anchor block measures $12-{ }^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

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Layout Ideas
