

# Shaded Nine Patch Star Supply List



This quilt measures 39" x 39".

This quilt is made with 12 - 6" finished Shaded Nine Patch units & 32 - 3" finished quarter square triangles, plus 4 - 4 color quarter square triangles for the cornerstones. Choose 6 fabrics and a background. You may choose Width of Fabric Strips (WOF) **OR** Fat Quarters and cut more strips. Refer to the Shaded Nine Patch Technique Sheet & the Tucker Trimmer I instructions for unit construction.

## Basic Supplies:

Cutting mat,  
 Rotary cutter with a new blade,  
 Sewing machine in good working order,  
 Scissors,  
 6"x24" & 6"x12" ruler  
 Thread, pins, pen  
 Invisi-Grip recommended

**NOTE:** The Shaded Nine Patch Technique Sheet has you cut fabric strips by positions 1 - 5. Position 4 strips are used twice. In the graphics it look as though you should cut Position 4 from the same fabric. When making the shaded nine patch star position 4 strip colors bump up next to each other. Therefore, it is better to choose 6 fabrics so you will have 2 fabrics for position 4 strip and a background.

**Background:** 1 Yard, Sub-cut 6 - 7"x 8" rectangles & 4 - 6 1/2" squares for the star corners

**Fat Quarters:** 6

**Border & Binding:** 1 yard

# Making 3 Color Quarter Square Triangles



## **Inner Border 3 Color Quarter Square Triangles:**

Background: Cut 2 – 4 ½” WOF strips, sub-cut into 16 – 4 ½” squares.

- Mark sewing lines on the 16 – 4 ½” background squares using the Magic Wand.

From the 6 fabric colors cut a variety of 16 – 4 ½” squares.

- Pair with the 16 Background – 4 ½” squares, Stitch on lines and cut apart making 32 Half Square Triangles (HST).
- Press toward the dark triangle

Pair the HST’s into 16 sets so they have different colors. Mark sewing lines on one of the pair’s back with the Magic Wand as before.

- Position on HST’s so background color is opposite each other, right sides together, nesting the seams.
- Stitch – Cut apart, swirl the seams and press.
- Trim to 3 ½” cut size, rotate & trim again

**Inner Border Cornerstones:** Cut four different color 4 ½” squares
